

2016 UAA JANICE K. BARDEN AVIATION SCHOLARSHIP

The National Business Aviation Association (NBAA) Charities annually awards \$1,000 to each of five undergraduates studying aviation-related curricula at NBAA and University Aviation Association (UAA) member institutions.

This scholarship is named for Janice Barden, who has been active in the aviation community for decades and has served as chair of the NBAA Convention Local Committee more than any other person in NBAA history.

Awards will be made to U.S. citizens without regard to sex, race, religion or national origin. Scholarships will be awarded by summer 2016, and checks will be made payable to the school. Scholarship recipients must use the funds by Dec. 31, 2016, or risk forfeit of the award.

The UAA Janice K. Barden Scholarship is one of several scholarships offered by NBAA Charities to promote professional development and business aviation careers. For all NBAA Charities scholarships, applicants are limited to receiving one award per person, per year. For more information, visit www.nbaa.org/scholarships.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicant must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
2. Applicant must be a full-time undergraduate student (sophomore or higher) enrolled in an aviation-related two-year or four-year degree program at an NBAA and University Aviation Association (UAA) member institution (see list provided). Contact your department head or advisor for the institution's NBAA and UAA membership numbers. This application is not complete if these numbers are missing.
3. Applicant must have a cumulative undergraduate grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale.
4. Fill out this application form in its entirety and sign it.
5. Submit a 250-word, typed, double-spaced essay describing your interest in and goals for a career in the business aviation industry. Your typed name must appear at the top of the page.
6. Submit an official transcript issued by the school, or a copy of the transcript. If you are transfer student, previous college transcripts are recommended.
7. Submit a current one-page resume with permanent home address.
8. Submit a letter of recommendation from a member of the aviation department faculty at the institution where you are currently enrolled.
9. Completed application package, which includes this form, one essay, one transcript, one resume and one letter of recommendation, must be received by NBAA no later than **Oct. 30, 2015**, to be considered for the scholarship.
